


Andy Johns Selected as 2018 Grand National Program Artist

Equine artist Andy Hartmeyer Johns (shown far right) has been selected to create the program cover of the 2018 Grand National & World Championship Morgan Horse Show®.

Andy's work can be found in the Museum of the Morgan Horse, the American Saddlebred Museum, galleries, juried art shows, as well as international and domestic private collections. She has attended major horse shows across the country, including the Lexington Junior League, the World Championships in Louisville and Oklahoma City, the Kansas City American Royal, Blue Ridge Classic in Asheville, NC, Big D (Dallas, TX), Oklahoma Centennial, and many more.
